Tactical Emergency Casualty Care (TECC) Courses are now being offered here in our Region! This TECC Course for FIRE/EMS is an 8-hour course with instruction to be delivered in a blended format. Some of the material will be didactic / lecture presentation intermixed with several psychomotor sessions, which will allow participants to have crucial hands-on training using a wide array of tactical emergency medical supplies, as well as provide an opportunity to practice the recommended techniques in a scenario-based environment.

Course Objectives:

- Examine and address the unique and challenging requirements of administering point of wounding medical care by Fire/Rescue/EMS personnel to patients during a high-threat incident
- Learn to distinguish between life-saving and secondary interventions, and when they should be applied based on the prevailing threat to responders and patients based on all three phases during integrated operations such as Rescue Task Force
- Proper application and interventions such as tourniquets, wound packing, pressure bandages, and other techniques to support tenants of damage control resuscitation.

EMS continuing education will be granted for full 8-hour course attendance
